## Package Change/NDC Update on Select ENBREL Products

The FDA has required an update to ENBREL volume descriptors.

This update does not result in any changes to product drug, dose, price, or reimbursement. It does trigger a requirement to update our National Drug Codes (NDC) on select ENBREL products.

## ACTIONS FOR YOUR PHARMACY

### Dispensing the new ENBREL NDCs

The old NDCs will continue to be covered/reimbursed. We do not expect the new NDCs to require a new Rx/PA.

Please note: When submitting the new 50 mg 1 pack (4 syringe) NDC for reimbursement, the volume amount will now adjust from 3.92 mL to 4.0 mL. For the old 50 mg NDCs, the quantity will remain 3.92 mL.

### Inventory Management

Amgen recommends depleting all inventory of the old NDCs before dispensing the new NDCs.

Please ensure that your dispensing system has the new NDCs loaded.

If you do not see the new NDCs, please contact your pharmacy operations or IS lead.

Wholesalers will begin carrying the new NDCs when they exhaust inventory of the old NDCs, which we anticipate will occur around mid to late August. After August, if you experience an out-of-stock of the old NDC, please order the new NDC.

Please update your systems to order the new NDCs when they are available at your wholesaler.
